

### 1. BHAVYA Portal Launched for 100 Industrial Parks

- Union Minister Piyush Goyal launched the "Bhavya" (Bharat Audyogik Vikas Yojana) portal in New Delhi.
- Aim: develop 100 world-class "plug and play" industrial parks across India via centre-state partnerships.
- Government allocated ₹33,000 crore for these parks; each park requires 25 to 100 acres of land.

### 2. Cabinet Approves 10-Year Extension of UDAN Scheme

- UDAN (Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik) was initially launched in 2016 by the Ministry of Civil Aviation.
- The Cabinet approved a 10-year extension (2026-27 to 2035-36) for the modified UDAN scheme.
- Set to launch on June 20, 2026, with a total budget outlay of ₹28,840 crore.
- Develop 100 new airports over 8 years (costing ₹12,159 crore).
- 3-year Operation & Maintenance (O&M) support to 441 aerodromes (airports/heliports) with ₹2,577 crore — capped at ₹3.06 crore/year for airports and ₹0.90 crore/year for heliports.
- Construct 200 modern helipads in remote, hilly, and island areas at ₹15 crore each (totaling ₹3,661 crore).
- Allocate ₹10,043 crore over 10 years for Viability Gap Funding (VGF) for airlines.

### 3. VINIMAY — Land Port Management System Launched

- Union Home Minister Amit Shah launched "VINIMAY", a Land Port Management System, in New Delhi.
- Developed by the Land Ports Authority of India (LPAI).

### 4. e-Jagriti Platform Wins Silver at National E-Governance Awards

- Launched on January 1, 2025; unified four legacy apps.
- The Department of Consumer Affairs' e-Jagriti platform won the Silver Award at the 29th National Awards for E-Governance (2026).

### 5. PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana Marks 2nd Anniversary

- On its 2-year anniversary, Union Minister Pralhad Joshi announced an interim target of 75 lakh rooftop solar installations by December 2026.
- Aims for 1 crore households by March 2027.

### 6. PMSMA Completes 10 Years — "A Decade of Care"

- Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA) launched by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW) in June 2016
- Completed 10 years ("A Decade of Care") on June 9, 2026.
- Provides 9 types of free, high-quality antenatal care screenings for pregnant women in their 2nd and 3rd trimesters.
- Checkups happen on the 9th of every month by specialist doctors.
- High-risk pregnancies get a red sticker; no-risk ones get a green sticker.
- A ₹75 coin and a ₹5 postal stamp were released to commemorate the anniversary.

### 7. Aatmanirbhar Panchayat Outreach Launched

- The Ministry of Panchayati Raj launched this under the Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.

### 8. Rahavir Scheme — Rapido Partners with MoRTH

- Ride-hailing company Rapido partnered with the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) to promote this scheme.

### 9. West Bengal Implements Ayushman Bharat (PM-JAY)

- West Bengal became the 36th and final State/UT to implement the Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY).
- Provides a ₹5 lakh health insurance cover per eligible BPL family.

### 10. IMD Launches 7th & 8th Regional Meteorological Centres

- The Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) launched its 7th and 8th regional centres.
- 7th centre in Jammu covers J&K, Ladakh, and Himachal Pradesh.
- 8th centre in Lucknow covers UP and Uttarakhand, inaugurated by Earth Sciences Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh and UP CM Yogi Adityanath.

### 11. India Gets Its 100th Ramsar Site

- On World Environment Day (June 5), the Jai Prakash Narayan Bird Sanctuary (Surha Taal) in Ballia, UP, became India's 100th Ramsar site.
- It is an oxbow lake formed by the Ganga River.
- India ranks 1st in Asia and 3rd globally for Ramsar sites.

### 12. NZP Saathi App Launched

- Union Minister of State for Environment Kirti Vardhan Singh launched the "NZP Saathi" (Saathi) app and self-ticketing kiosks for the National Zoological Park in New Delhi.
- Offers a smart digital guide, park map tracking, UPI payment, and four tour formats: Express, Family, Grand Zoo, and Personalize My Tour.

### 13. Himachal Pradesh Launches Safai Mitra Scheme

- HP CM Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu launched the scheme to empower informal waste management workers.

### 14. MP's Jal Ganga Samvardhan Abhiyan Gains International Acclaim

- Madhya Pradesh's "Jal Ganga Samvardhan Abhiyan" (rejuvenating water bodies through community participation) gained international acclaim.

### 15. University of Liverpool to Open Campus in Bengaluru

- The University of Liverpool (UK) received UGC approval to open an international branch in Alambic City, Whitefield, Bengaluru by August 2026.
- It is the second UK university in India after the University of Southampton.

### 16. First Mango Export from India to the UK

- APEDA handled the first commercial export of 1.5 metric tons of fresh Amrapali mangoes from Jharkhand to London.
- Static: APEDA was established in 1986 under the Commerce Ministry.
- Jharkhand CM is Hemant Soren; Governor is Santosh Kumar Gangwar.

### 17. First Tezpur Litchi Export to Dubai

- APEDA facilitated the first export of GI-tagged Tezpur Litchi from Assam directly to Dubai.
- Static: GI tags are managed by DPIIT, valid for 10 years; Darjeeling Tea was India's first GI tag.

### 18. RBI Annual Priorities & Regulatory Updates for FY 2026-27

- FY 2026-27 priorities: customer protection and a strengthened credit ecosystem via early risk detection, data-driven supervision, AI-monitoring, and uniform rules.
- KYC: Re-KYC guidelines and Officially Valid Documents (OVDs) being updated; Video KYC now available for Non-Resident Indians (NRIs) abroad.
- RBI will penalize banks forcefully mis-selling third-party products (e.g., insurance on home loans).
- Launched a "Switch On/Switch Off" feature to disable specific payment channels and a "Kill Switch" to block all debit transactions instantly.
- The "Mule Hunter AI" (by the RBI Innovation Hub) will track fraudulent accounts.
- A new framework will standardize "Shared Loan Arrangements" for multi-bank funding; RBI is launching a Unified Lending Interface (ULI) for competitive loan applications.
- Digital Rupee (CBDC) is expanding into Direct Benefit Transfers (DBT) and retail; MoUs signed with Singapore and under discussion with the UAE for cross-border transactions.
- Recognized the Sahi Foundation as a Self-Regulatory Organization (SRO) for India's Account Aggregator ecosystem.
- Digital banking frauds decreased in volume (from 23,000 to 10,014) but increased in stolen value by 46% to ₹48,210 crore.
- Public Sector Banks accounted for 74% (₹35,000 crore).

### 19. SBI presented an ₹8,813 crore dividend cheque to Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman for FY 2025-26 at ₹17.35 per share.

### 20. India GDP Estimates & Economic Forecasts (FY26-FY27)

- NSO GDP Estimates: economy grew by 7.7% in FY26 (+60 bps from FY25); revised base year 2020-23. FY26 Real GDP: ₹323.12 lakh crore; Nominal GDP: ₹346.36 lakh crore.

- SBI EcoWrap Report: FY 2025-26 GDP revised to 7.7% (Q4 growth 7.8% and 9.9% service-sector expansion); predicts 12.5% to 13% for FY27.

- RBI's 100th Survey of Professional Forecasters: lowered FY27 real GDP growth forecast from 6.9% to 6.5%.

### **22. Effective April 1, 2026, foreign portfolio investors (FPIs) will pay zero tax on interest income and capital gains from government securities.**

### **23. Bandhan Bank Launches 3-in-1 Account**

- Kolkata-based Bandhan Bank partnered with Centrum Finserve Limited to launch a unified Savings, Demat, and Trading account platform.

### **24. The Competition Commission of India (CCI) approved South Africa's Sanlam Group acquiring a 2.80% stake in Shriram Life Insurance.**

- Static: CCI formed in 2003 under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs; Chairperson is Ravneet Kaur.

### **25. PM Modi's Diplomatic Tour of France & Slovakia**

- From June 13 to 19, PM Modi visits France and Slovakia.
- In France, he meets President Emmanuel Macron and attends the G7 Summit in Evian as an outreach partner.
- In Slovakia, he visits Bratislava.
- G7 Countries: Canada, USA, Japan, Italy, Germany, Britain, France.

### **26. India-Nepal Bilateral Deals**

- Nepal Foreign Minister Shashir Kansal visited India (June 5-7).

### **27. Bonn Climate Conference 2026 (Health Summit)**

- The SB 64 edition under the UNFCCC took place in Bonn, Germany (June 8-18), preceding COP 31 in Turkey.
- Future COP pipeline: COP 30 Belem (Brazil), COP 31 Turkey, COP 32 Ethiopia, COP 33 Australia.

### **28. South Korea-Japan 'SAREX' Naval Drill**

- After a 9-year gap, the biennial SAREX naval exercise occurred at Goto Island (Japan) near Jeju Island.

### **29. Assam-EU Sign "Blue Valley Cluster" MoU**

- Assam and the European Union (EU) signed an MoU for the "Blue Valley Cluster".

### **30. NASSCOM InnoTrek UK 2026**

- NASSCOM launched its 11th InnoTrek in London to connect Indian deep-tech startups (AI, semiconductors) with international investors

### **31. Global Military Spender Reports (SIPRI & CRI)**

- Per the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI) and CRI reports, India is the 5th largest global military spender (\$91.2 billion to \$92.1 billion estimates for 2025).
- USA is #1 (\$954 billion), followed by China, Russia, and Germany.
- India is the 2nd largest arms importer (behind Ukraine).

### **32. Defense Solar Power Project in Sitapur**

- The Defense Ministry approved a 250 MW solar project with Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) on 850 acres of defense land in Sitapur, UP.
- Implemented by NTPC.

### **33. IAF & IIT Bombay Develop AI Health Monitoring for SU-30 MKI**

### **34. India Joins Project Glasswing (Cybersecurity)**

- India joined Anthropic's global initiative "Project Glasswing", using "Mythos AI" to identify software vulnerabilities and boost digital defenses.

### **35. New Mushroom Species Discovered in Arunachal Pradesh**

- The ICAR discovered a pear-shaped "Yellow Puffball Mushroom" (*Bovista colorata*) in the Longding district of Arunachal Pradesh — a first for the state.

### 36. First World Yogasana Championship

- Held at EKA Arena, Ahmedabad (June 4–8).
- India dominated with 114 medals (102 Gold, 9 Silver, 3 Bronze); Japan 2nd, Argentina 3rd.
- Mascot: "Veer the Lion" (Asiatic lion).

### 37. SAFF Women's Championship 2026

- India won its 6th title, defeating Bangladesh 3-1 at Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, Goa.
- Panthoi Chanu — Best Goalkeeper; Aveka Singh — top scorer (4 goals).

### 38. Under-18 Asia Cup Hockey 2026

- India won Gold, defeating Japan 4-1 in Kakamigahara, Japan; Pakistan won Bronze.

### 39. French Open 2026 (125th Edition)

- Held in Paris. Alexander Zverev (Germany) won Men's Singles; Mirra Andreeva (Russia) won Women's Singles.

### 40. Norway Chess 2026

- Indian GM R. Praggnanandhaa won the title, defeating Dishmen Zervika.
- Bibisara Assaubayeva (Kazakhstan) won the women's title.

### 41. Asian Individual Chess Championship

- 19-year-old Indian IM Savitha Shri Bhaskar won women's gold in Mongolia.
- China's Kong Xiangrui won the open section.

### 42. Monaco Grand Prix

- Andrea Kimi Antonelli (Mercedes, Italy) became the youngest winner, followed by Lewis Hamilton and Isack Hadjar.

### 43. FIBA 3x3 World Cup (Warsaw, Poland)

- Latvia won the Men's title (beat Germany); USA won the Women's title (beat Australia).
- Static: FIBA established 1932, HQ in Switzerland.

### 44. Javelin National Record at Rome Diamond League

- Sri Lankan athlete Rumesh became the 4th Asian to cross 90m, throwing 92.62m at the Diamond League in Rome, setting a national record.

### 45. Important Days

- June 7 — World Food Safety Day: Theme — "From Burden to Solution: Safe Food Everywhere".
- June 8 — World Brain Tumor Day: promoted early diagnosis and research.
- June 8 — UN World Oceans Day: Theme — "Reimagining beyond the world we know: a new relationship with our ocean".
- June 9 — World Accreditation Day: Theme — "Innovation, Trust, and Sustainability: The Power of Accreditation".
- June 10 — International Day for Dialogue among Civilizations: declared by UNGA in 2024 (observed for the 2nd time); 2026 Theme — "The Imperative of Dialogue among Civilizations in a Changing World".
