

### 1. PM Modi – Longest Continuously Serving Elected Prime Minister

- A resolution was passed congratulating PM Narendra Modi on becoming the longest continuously serving elected Prime Minister of India, completing 4,399 consecutive days.
- He surpassed former PM Jawaharlal Nehru's elected tenure of 4,398 days.
- Including his non-elected tenure before the first elections, Nehru remains India's overall longest-serving Prime Minister at 6,131 days.

### 2. 11th NITI Aayog Governing Council Meeting

- PM Modi chaired the 11th Governing Council meeting of NITI Aayog in New Delhi.
- Theme: "Inclusive Human Development for Viksit Bharat@2047".
- Focused on four core pillars: foundational human capital, future-ready skills, productive employment, and health/nutrition.

### 3. The Union Cabinet approved ₹2,533 crore for establishing a Central Government Office Complex in Amaravati, Andhra Pradesh.

### 4. The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) updated Visa & Immigration Rules

- Foreigners holding visas valid for 180 days or less must now apply for extensions before their visa expires, rather than up to 14 days after.
- The requirement to register a child's birth within 30 days was removed if one parent is an Indian citizen and the child retains Indian citizenship.

### 5. VINIMAY – Unified Digital Platform for Land Ports

- Home Minister Amit Shah launched "VINIMAY", a unified digital platform to manage cargo and passenger vehicles at land ports.
- There are currently 15 operational land ports.

### 6. PMSMA Completes 10 Years

- Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA) was launched by PM Modi on June 9, 2016, and is implemented by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
- It provides free, comprehensive antenatal care to pregnant women on the 9th of every month.
- The maternal health scheme completed its 10th anniversary on June 9, 2026.
- Union Health Minister J.P. Nadda launched a nationwide celebration to mark this "decade of care".

### 7. "G Ram G" Yojana to Replace MGNREGA

- The scheme replaces the existing MGNREGA (Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act).
- "G Ram G" Yojana is set to officially launch on July 1, 2026.
- The acronym stands for "Guarantee for Rozgar And Aajeevika Mission Gramin".
- It increases guaranteed rural workdays from 100 to 125 and covers 2.6 lakh panchayats across 36 states and UTs.
- The Ministry of Rural Development has allocated ₹95,692 crores for the program.

### 8. Textile PLI Scheme – 96 Companies Approved

- The Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for textiles was launched in March 2020 by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) to transform India into a global manufacturing hub.
- It targets Man-Made Fiber (MMF) and technical textiles.

### 9. BHAVYA Portal Launched

- Minister of Commerce and Industry Piyush Goyal launched the Bharat Audyogik Vikas Yojana (BHAVYA) portal, developed by NICDC.
- Backed by a ₹33,660 crore cabinet approval.
- Aims to develop 100 investment-ready industrial parks over six years under a 51:49 Central-State partnership model.

### 10. Books

- "Giorgia's Vision" by Giorgia Meloni

### 11. Rah Veer Yojana & Rapido Partnership

- Rah Veer Yojana is a road safety scheme initially launched by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH).
- It rewards individuals who rush accident victims to hospitals within the first "Golden Hour" with ₹25,000 and immunity from police harassment.

### 12. Jal Jeevan Mission 2.0

- Jal Jeevan Mission 2.0 aims to provide tap water connections to 19.36 crore rural households by December 2028 with an allocation of ₹8.69 lakh crore.

### 13. Air India "Easy Connect" Model

- Air India launched the "Easy Connect" model in collaboration with the Ministry of Civil Aviation.
- It targets returning Indian immigrants, allowing them to complete luggage check-in and customs clearance at their local city airport to avoid crowding at major hubs like Delhi.
- Varanasi is the first of 17 planned destinations to implement this.

### 14. India's New National Firsts

- India's first Skycast system was launched at the Indira Gandhi International Airport in New Delhi.
- India's first indigenous super pressure platform, named "Mission Sana", was introduced.

### 15. Himachal Pradesh – Krishak Bakri Palan Yojana

- Launched by the Animal Husbandry Department in 2021 for goat farming and meat production.
- Provides a 60% financial subsidy, technical support, and training by Senior Veterinary Officers.

### 16. Uttarakhand – Science, Technology & Innovation (STI) Policy

- Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhama launched the Science, Technology, and Innovation (STI) Policy.
- Aims to build a research-oriented economy utilizing AI, blockchain, and drones in governance, healthcare, agriculture, and education.

### 17. Kerala – Aswas 2026

- Kerala launched Aswas 2026, a 100-day one-time settlement scheme running from June 1 to August 31, 2026.
- Aids defaulters of primary agricultural cooperative societies by suspending attachment proceedings, waiving penal interest, and offering up to a 15% interest concession.

### 18. Delhi – Pink Saheli Card

- Expands an initiative that originally started for women in March 2025.
- Delhi launched the Pink Saheli Card allowing transgender individuals to access free bus services.

### 19. Gujarat – Operation Milap

- Launched by Gujarat Police on May 7, 2026, to track down missing persons.
- Successfully reunited 1,470 people in one month (highest from Surat), according to Deputy CM Harsh Sanghavi.

### 20. Madhya Pradesh – Kith Bachau Abhyan & Caracal Sighting

- A month-long initiative called "Kith Bachau Abhyan" was launched by Shivraj Singh Chouhan.
- A rare Caracal wild cat was spotted in Kuno National Park.

### 21. Uttar Pradesh – Nosa Shy Vatika

- The "Nosa Shy Vatika" was inaugurated in Lucknow.

### 22. India's GDP Growth Projections

- Fitch Ratings downgraded India's GDP prediction from 6.7% to 6.4%, citing the West Asia crisis, rising crude oil prices, and a weakening rupee.
- The World Bank's 'Global Economic Prospects' report projects India's GDP growth at 6.6% for FY27 and 7.2% for FY28.

### 23. WPI to be Replaced by PPI

- The government is replacing the Wholesale Price Index (WPI) with a Producer Price Index (PPI).
- The WPI base year is being revised from 2011-12 to 2022-23, effective June 15.
- The new PPI structure will include the prices of services (banking, insurance, telecommunications) for the first time.

### 24. Key Economic Indicators (IIP, UPI, GST)

- Industrial output (IIP) for April stood at 4.9%.
- In May, UPI hit a record 2 billion transactions worth ₹29.9 lakh crore.
- Gross GST collection for May 2026 was ₹1.94 lakh crore (a 3.2% increase from May 2025), led by Maharashtra, UP, Karnataka, Gujarat, and Tamil Nadu.
- April 2026 recorded the highest-ever GST collection at ₹2.43 lakh crore.

### **25. RBI Recognises Sahamati as SRO for Account Aggregators**

- Account Aggregators consolidate financial data for loan assessments; 17 platforms are currently operational.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) recognized the Sahamati Foundation as a Self-Regulatory Organization (SRO).
- Requires a minimum net worth of ₹2 crore and caps single-entity holding at 10%.

### **26. RBI Eases Lending Norms for REITs & InvITs**

- The RBI eased lending norms effective October 1, 2026, allowing banks to lend to SEBI-regulated, listed trusts.
- Condition: at least 80% of assets must consist of cash/revenue-generating properties operational with positive cash flows for over a year.

### **27. CGSMFI 2.0 Extended**

- The Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro Finance Institutions (CGSMFI) 2.0 was extended to August 31, 2026, or until ₹20,000 crore in guarantees are issued, facilitated by NCGTC.
- The maximum loan limit for large NBFCs and MFIs increased from ₹300 crore to ₹1,000 crore (subject to 20% of their AUM).

### **28. ECLGS 5.0 Milestone**

- The Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) version 5.0 issued 1 lakh guarantees covering ₹48,484 crore in loans (96% issued by Public Sector Banks).

### **29. Other Financial Approvals & Penalties**

- Nuvama Wealth Management received SEBI approval to launch a mutual fund business.
- The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) imposed a ₹1 crore penalty on Nissan Renault Financial Services.
- Va Fintech (Vona Fintech) received NPCI approval as a biller operating unit on the Bharat Connect platform.

### **30. Silver Import Rules Tightened**

- Silver imports surged to \$20 billion in 2025-26.
- The government tightened silver import rules, now requiring valid authorization from the Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT).
- Digital processing must be done through the India International Bullion Exchange (IIBX).

### **31. Wheat Procurement & Agricultural Exports**

- The government procured 35 million tonnes of wheat in the Rabi marketing season (highest in 5 years) at an MSP of ₹2,425 per quintal.
- The all-time high remains 43.43 million tonnes in 2020-21.
- The Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) exported a 1 metric ton consignment of GI-tagged Tezpur Litchi from Assam to Dubai.
- Assam's GI-tagged Joha rice was previously exported to the UK and Italy.

### **32. CSR Funds Allowed in Zero Coupon Zero Principal Bonds**

- The Ministry of Corporate Affairs allowed companies to invest up to 10% of their annual CSR funds in "Zero Coupon Zero Principal" bonds issued on the Social Stock Exchange by not-for-profits.
- Mandatory 2% CSR spend applies to companies with a net worth >₹500 crore, turnover >₹1,000 crore, or net profit >₹5 crore.

### **33. BSNL – IIT Kanpur 6G & LiFi MoU**

- BSNL and IIT Kanpur signed an MoU to advance next-generation 6G and LiFi technologies.

### **34. India's Solar Sector Growth (IRENA)**

- According to IRENA statistics, India added 37 GW of solar last year, multiplying its capacity 55-fold from 2.8 GW in 2014 to 155 GW in 2026.
- India has surpassed the US to become the world's 2nd largest solar growth market (behind China).
- Globally, India is 3rd in total renewable and solar capacity, and 4th in wind.

### 35. 52nd G7 Summit

- PM Modi traveled to Evian, France, for the 52nd G7 Summit (June 15-17) as a "Partner Country".
- This is India's 13th participation and PM Modi's 7th consecutive appearance.

### 36. Global Peace Index 2026

- The 20th edition by the Institute for Economics and Peace ranked India 127th out of 163 countries (score 2.409).
- Iceland topped for the 19th year, followed by New Zealand, Switzerland, Slovenia, and Ireland.
- Least peaceful was Russia (163), followed by Sudan (162), Israel (159), and Ukraine.
- Western/Central Europe is the most peaceful region, MENA is the least, and South Asia recorded the largest regional deterioration.

### 37. Bilateral Relations & Pacts

- India and Nepal launched a cross-border remittance mechanism connecting India's UPI with Nepal's NPI for real-time P2P transfers; India and Cambodia are planning similar cross-border UPI payments.
- The India-Oman Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) has come into force.
- India and Brunei held discussions to strengthen bilateral ties and parliamentary cooperation.

### 38. Multilateral Forums (BRICS & ILC)

- India will host the 13th BRICS Urbanization Forum in New Delhi and the BRICS Culture Working Group in Varanasi.
- The Indian delegation, led by Shobha Karandlaje, attended the 114th International Labour Conference (ILC) in Geneva, focusing on labor reforms.

### 39. UN Appointments & Aid

- Austria, Kyrgyzstan, Portugal, Trinidad and Tobago, and Zimbabwe were selected for the UN Security Council (UNSC) for 2027-2028.
- Indian UN representative P. Harish announced \$2.5 million funding to UNRWA to combat the Gaza humanitarian crisis.

### 40. Global Legislation

- Canada introduced legislation banning social media for children under 16 without safety proofs, joining Australia, Brazil, and Indonesia.
- South Korea nominated the incoming Minister of SMEs as its 1st female PM of the current administration (2nd in history).

### 41. Important Appointments

- Sanjay Lohiya – Nominated as a Director on the RBI and SBI Central Boards, replacing M. Nagaraju.
- Kumar Shankar – Managing Director of Indraprastha Gas Limited (IGL), replacing Kamal Kishore Chatiwal.
- Banwarilal Purohit & Deepak Parekh – Appointed President and Vice President respectively of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan.
- Vice Admiral Ajay Kochhar – Assumed charge as Vice Chief of Naval Staff.
- Rajesh Kumar Singh – Appointed MD of Canara Bank.
- Prashant Sitaram Lokhande – Appointed CBSE Chairman.
- K. Shivakumar – Mentioned as Karnataka's new Chief Minister.
- Shreyanka Patil – Brand ambassador for KLF Nirmal (coconut hair oil) while playing in the ICC Women's T20 World Cup.
- Shah Rukh Khan – Brand ambassador for Visa.

### 42. Awards & Honours

- EMBO Gold Medal 2026 – Won by Indian-origin scientist Gautam Dey and Switzerland's Omayya Judin for research on the evolutionary origins of nuclear organization and cell division.
- President's Police Color Award – Honored to Sikkim Police.

### 43. FIFA World Cup 2026

- The 23rd edition kicked off June 12 at Estadio Azteca, Mexico City.
- Co-hosted by Canada, USA, and Mexico, it expanded to 48 teams and 104 matches.
- Mascots: Maple, Jau, and Cletch; official song: "Dai Dai" by Shakira and Burna Boy.

### 44. ICC Men's ODI Rankings

- India is ranked #1 (118 points), followed by New Zealand (113 points) and Australia (109 points).

### 45. French Open 2026

- Germany's Alexander Zverev won the Men's Singles title.

### 46. Ulaanbaatar Open Wrestling (Mongolia)

- India won 17 medals (8 Gold, 9 Bronze).
- Gold medalists: Deepak, Sagar, Dinesh, Manisha, Neha, Kajal, Sunil Kumar, and Nitish Kumar.

### 47. New Taipei City Athletics Open (Taiwan)

- India secured 4 medals.
- Shaili Singh won gold in women's long jump (6.58m); the women's relay team won gold.
- Tejas Shirse won silver in 110m hurdles, and Animesh Kujur won silver.

### 48. Other Sports News

- Meghalaya will host the 39th National Games.
- Indian spinner Manav Suthar signed a short-term contract with Warwickshire County Cricket Club.

### 49. Obituary – Bharathiraja

- Veteran Tamil filmmaker and actor Bharathiraja passed away at the age of 84.
