

1. A major hydro power and Kishau Multipurpose Dam Project. approved to harness the Tons River, a tributary of the Yamuna.

- The structure straddles the border between Uttarakhand (Dehradun district) and Himachal Pradesh (Sirmour district).

2. UDAN Regional Connectivity Scheme Extended

- The Cabinet modified and extended the Regional Connectivity Scheme (UDAN) for 10 more years — from FY 2026-27 to FY 2035-36.
- Backed by budgetary support of ₹28,840 crore.
- Aims to develop 100 airports and enhance affordable air travel.

3. The Digital India Bhashini Division (DIBD) partnered with the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) to provide an AI translation tool for public procurement.

- Enables GeM services in 22 officially recognized Indian languages.

4. The National Biodiversity Authority (NBA) formed a 1-year expert committee on Agro-biodiversity conservation.

- Chaired by Padma Shri Dr. P.L. Gautam.

5. The Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) published a new standard (IS 20201:2026) for Community Seed Bank Management Requirements.

6. Prime Minister Narendra Modi attended the 52nd G7 Summit hosted in Évian-les-Bains, France, where India was a guest.

7. PM Modi became the first Indian Prime Minister to visit Slovakia since its independence in 1993.

- PM Modi received Slovakia's highest national honor — his 33rd international award.

8. India-Kiribati Health Cooperation

- India's High Commissioner Suneet Mehta met with Kiribati's Health Minister Bootii Nauan.
- Kiribati facts: capital **South Tarawa/Tarawa**, uses the Australian Dollar(AUD).

9. 16th BRICS Agriculture Ministers Meeting

- Concluded in Indore, Madhya Pradesh.
- Launched a tree plantation campaign called "BRICS Vatika".
- Approved the AI-driven "BRICS Network on Digital Agriculture", managed by IIT Delhi.

10. India-Denmark Shipwreck Mission

- India and the National Museum of Denmark signed an agreement to locate the Oresund, a 17th-century Danish ship that sank in 1619.
- The ship sank near Karaikal, Puducherry.

11. Global Peace Index 2026

- Released by the Institute for Economics and Peace.
- Iceland ranked #1 for the 19th consecutive year.
- India ranked 127th (changing from 115th in 2025).
- Russia is the least peaceful(163rd); Bhutan(16th) is the most peaceful in South Asia.

12. Uzbekistan became the 10th member and the first Central Asian country to join the New Development Bank (NDB).

13. The United States Department of Defense officially renamed the US Indo-Pacific Command back to its previous name, the US Pacific Command.

14. India Receives Record Inward Remittances

- India became the first nation in history to surpass the \$100 billion remittance mark back in 2022, when total inflows reached \$111.22 billion
- In the 2025–26 fiscal year, India's core workers' remittances hit a record **\$110.47 billion**, reflecting a **26% Year-on-Year (YoY) increase** from \$87.55 billion in the prior period.
- Top 5 Global Recipients: India, Mexico, China, the Philippines and France.

15. RBI Consumer Confidence Survey (May 2026)

- Urban Consumer Confidence Index (CSI): Dropped to 90.7 in May 2026 from 95.7 in March.
- Rural Consumer Confidence Index (CSI): Dropped to 95.2 in May 2026 from 98.0 in March.

16. RBI Restrictions on Mogaveera Co-operative Bank

- The RBI imposed a six-month restriction on this Mumbai-based bank starting June 12th.
- It cannot issue/renew loans without RBI approval; depositor withdrawals are capped at ₹1 lakh.

17. Bank of Baroda launched the "bob Golden Goal Deposit Scheme" for deposits below ₹3 crore.

- It features a fixed maturity period of **555 day**

18. Yes Bank and Northern Arc Capital partnered to expand digital lending and formal credit access

19. India Achieves Record Defense Production

- India achieved an all-time high defense production of ₹1.78 lakh crore in FY 2025-26.
- Defense exports surged by 62.66% to reach ₹38,424 crore.

20. DRDO Tests Ballistic Missile Defence (BMD) System

- India's DRDO successfully conducted three consecutive flight tests in Odisha for a multi-layer BMD interceptor missile.
- Known as India's "Iron Dome", it destroys incoming missiles mid-air.

21. INS Tarkash Visits Seychelles

- The Indian Navy and Coast Guard sent INS Tarkash to Port Victoria on a friendly visit to build Indian Ocean relations.
- INS Tarkash is a Talwar-class frigate (built in Yantar Shipyard, Russia; commissioned Nov 9, 2012).

22. First Made-in-India Airbus C295 Test Flight

- Tata Advanced Systems Ltd (collaborating with Airbus) completed the maiden test flight of the C295 military transport aircraft from Vadodara, Gujarat.

23. Lt Gen Dheeraj Seth was appointed as the next Chief of Army Staff, succeeding Gen Upendra Dwivedi starting June 30th.

24. India introduced Pluvicto, an advanced "guided missile approach" radioligand therapy by Novartis.

25. India launched 'Varya', a made-in-India AI video story generation model to distill complex ideas into simple videos.

26. RBI Reelethon 2026 — Cyber Fraud Awareness

- RBI Thiruvananthapuram launched a state-wide reel-making competition and cyber fraud awareness campaign across 150 colleges in Kerala.
- Targets youth; addresses frauds like fake loan apps, digital arrests, and investment scams.
- Cash prizes: ₹75,000 (1st), ₹50,000 (2nd), and ₹25,000 (3rd).

27. A temporary ban on Telegram was applied under Section 69A of the IT Act 2000

28. Geographical Indication (GI) Tags

- Granted by the Geographical Indication Registry in Chennai, governed by the GI of Goods Act 1999, facilitated by NABARD, and valid for 10 years.

30. 2026 Global Wind Conference in Goa (Theme: "Wind Energy: From Ambition to Acceleration").

31. World's Most Beautiful Airports

- Navi Mumbai International Airport (Terminal 1) and Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport (Guwahati, Terminal 2) — both operated by Adani — were ranked among the top 7 globally.
- Ranked by the Prix Versailles architecture and design awards, presented at UNESCO HQ in Paris.

32. Sports

- Archery: Indian archer Bommadevara Dhiraj won two gold medals at the Archery World Cup Stage 3 in Turkey (Men's Recurve Individual, and Recurve Mixed Team with Kumkum Mohat). In both, they defeated South Korea.
- Tennis: 13-year-old Shrishti Kiran (Bengaluru) became World No. 1 in the Under-13 category of the ITF Junior World Ranking.
- Football: Sarpreet Singh became the first Indian-origin footballer to start a FIFA World Cup match. Wearing jersey #10, he played 92 minutes for New Zealand against Iran on June 15, 2026, in California.
- Cricket Retirement: New Zealand's Kane Williamson announced his retirement from international cricket (110 tests, 955 runs, 54.1 average, led NZ to 2019/2021 WC finals).
- Fencing: India will host the 26th Senior Asian Fencing Championship (a 2028 Olympic qualifier) for the first time from June 19 at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi.
- Formula 1: Lewis Hamilton (driving for Ferrari) won the Barcelona/Catalunya Grand Prix.

33. Important Days

- June 17 — World Day to Combat Desertification and Drought: Theme: "Rangelands Recognize Respect and Restore".
- June 17 — World Crocodile Day: Theme: "Legacy in Every Scale". Crocodiles are 200-million-year-old "living fossils" and "keystone species". India's Project Crocodile launched in 1975.
- June 18 — Autistic Pride Day: Theme: "Autistic Voices Leading the Narrative". Highlights that autistic brains function differently and it is not a disease. Established in 2005 by "Aspies for Freedom". (World Autism Awareness Day is April 2.)
- June 18 — Sustainable Gastronomy Day: annually observed.
- June 21 — 12th International Day of Yoga: led by PM Modi from Kolkata's Red Road. Theme: "Yoga for Healthy Aging".
