

1. Supreme Court Declares Right to Walk a Fundamental Right

- The Supreme Court declared walking on a safe, demarcated footpath as a fundamental right under Article 19(1)(d) (freedom of movement) and Article 21 (right to life).

2. The Supreme Court appointed a committee headed by Kanchan Devi to balance forest conservation with development and mining in the Aravalli range.

3. Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (PM-JUGA)

- Formerly known as the PM Janjatiya Unnat Gram Abhiyan, this massive umbrella scheme is for tribal welfare.
- Title Meaning: "Dharti Aaba" (Father of the Earth) honors the tribal leader and anti-colonial icon Birsa Munda.

4. PM Kisan Yojana — 23rd Installment Released

- PM Narendra Modi released the 23rd installment, transferring ₹18,880 crore directly into farmers' accounts.
- The launch took place in Kolkata to coincide with West Bengal's Foundation Day on June 20th.

5. Multi-Lane Free Flow (Barrier-less) Tolling System in Rajasthan

- The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) launched Rajasthan's first barrier-less tolling system at the Daulatpura/Daulatpur Toll Plaza on NH-48 (Delhi-Jaipur).
- High-resolution cameras automatically deduct tolls via FASTags without cars stopping.
- India's very first such system was set up in Gujarat.

6. Odisha Development Projects in Mayurbhanj

- PM Modi and President Droupadi Murmu visited Mayurbhanj, Odisha (coinciding with President Murmu's 68th birthday).
- Allocated ₹47,600 crore for various development projects.
- Launched the Indravati Pumped Storage Project for electricity generation.
- Declared Pahadpur in Mayurbhanj a "Solar Village".

7. National Test House Testing Facilities, Mumbai

- Minister Pralhad Joshi inaugurated modern testing facilities at the National Test House in Mumbai

8. RBI Relaxes CRAR for ECLGS 5.0

- The ECLGS 5.0 aids businesses impacted by the West Asia crisis.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) relaxed Capital to Risk-Weighted Assets Ratio (CRAR) requirements for banks lending under the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) 5.0.
- Limits: ₹100 crore for MSMEs (up to 10-year tenure) and ₹1,500 crore for airlines (up to 7-year tenure).
- Benefit Details: 75% of the loan carries a 0% risk weight, and the remaining 25% carries a reduced risk weight of 20%. Banks must disburse approved loans within 30 days to qualify.

9. RBI issued new regulations for Payment System Operators (PSOs) under the Payment and Settlement System Act of 2007.

- Caps foreign investments from FATF non-compliant jurisdictions to under 20% aggregate voting power.

10. RBI Revamps Lead Bank Scheme (LBS)

- RBI revised Lead Bank Scheme (LBS) guidelines to enhance priority sector lending and financial inclusion.
- Rooted in the Target Area Approach (suggested by the Gadgil and Nariman committees).

11. RBI Monetary Policy & Penalties

- The RBI Monetary Policy Committee kept the repo rate unchanged at 5.25%.
- Imposed a ₹2.49 lakh penalty on Canara Bank.
- The RBI also canceled the license of **Shree Mahalaxmi Urban Co-operative Credit Bank Ltd., Gokak, Karnataka**, under the Banking Regulation Act.

12. SEBI Quick Transmission Process (QTP)

- SEBI introduced a faster mechanism for transferring shares to legal heirs without mandatorily requiring a PAN card or a court-issued will/probate for specific limits.

- The limit for skipping a probate was doubled to ₹30 lakh for demat accounts (from ₹15 lakh) and to ₹10 lakh for physical shares (from ₹5 lakh).

13. BSE launched India's first saatvik 100 index to promote ethical-based investing.

14. The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) constituted a 7-member working group on Artificial Intelligence.

- Chaired by Professor Sandeep K. Shukla, to guide AI adoption and governance in the insurance sector.

15. Reliance's 'Five S' Leadership Model

- Mukesh Ambani unveiled a new framework ('Five S' Model) to guide generational leadership transition.
- Akash Ambani will lead technology/AI, Isha Ambani will lead retail/FMCG, and Anant Ambani will handle energy.

16. New Deposit Schemes — Federal Bank & Bank of Baroda

- Federal Bank: Launched the FCNR Max Deposit Scheme, offering 6.25% annual interest on US dollar-denominated deposits for NRIs (3 to 5 years tenure).
- Bank of Baroda: Launched the "Golden Gold Deposit Scheme", a 555-day retail term deposit scheme for amounts below ₹3 crore.

17. Indian Navy Commissions Three Indigenous Ships

- Three indigenous naval platforms were launched/commissioned in Kolkata.
- INS Dunagiri: A stealth guided-missile frigate built under Project 17A by GRSE.
- INS Sanshodhak: A Survey Vessel Large for ocean mapping and surveillance.
- INS Agray: An Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) Shallow Water Craft of the Arnala class.

18. National Military Drone Technology Hub at IIT Kanpur

- The Defence Ministry approved ₹500 crore to build this hub at the IIT Kanpur campus (Uttar Pradesh) to develop drones for the Indian Army.

19. Union Minister Pralhad Joshi launched WT Marut (Wind Turbine Materials and Resource Tracker) in Goa during the Global Wind Day conference.

20. 114th International Labor Conference (ILC): Held in Geneva, Switzerland

21. BRICS Agriculture Minister's Meeting: Hosted in Indore, Madhya Pradesh.

22. The World Bank approved a ₹4,000 crore loan for Haryana to support its water security project.

23. Key Appointments

- UCO Bank: Rajendra Kumar Saoo (Executive Director) was given additional charge as MD and CEO.
- Indian Air Force: Air Marshal Ashutosh Dixit was appointed as the next Vice Chief of Air Staff.
- India AI Mission: Saurabh Vijay was appointed as the new CEO.
- Indraprastha Gas Limited (IGL): Kumar Shanker was appointed as the new MD.
- RBI Central Board: Sanjay Lohiya was appointed.

24. Wolf Prize in Physics 2026 — Jainendra K. Jain

- Jainendra K. Jain was a joint recipient of the **2025 Wolf Prize in Physics**, along with James P. Eisenstein and Mordehai Heiblum.
- Indian-origin physicist Jainendra K. Jain (an IIT Kanpur alumnus from Rajasthan) became the first person of Indian origin to win the prestigious Wolf Prize in Physics (considered equivalent to the Nobel Prize).

25. Indian Athletics Awards 2025

- Neeraj Chopra — Men's Athlete of the Year.
- Parul Chaudhary — Women's Athlete of the Year.
- Legend PT Usha — Lifetime Achievement Award.

26. Sports

- Athletics: At the 2026 Doha Diamond League, India's Neeraj Chopra secured fourth place with an 85.69m throw. Romesh Taranga (Sri Lanka) came first, followed by Anderson Peters and Curtis Thompson.
- Yoga: India hosted the first-ever World Yogasana Championship and dominated the tally with 114 medals (including 102 gold).

- Cricket — Smriti Mandhana (vice-captain) was the only Indian featured on Time Magazine's "100 Most Influential People in Sports" list.

27. Osmania University (located in Hyderabad, Telangana) became the first university in India to simultaneously achieve four ISO certifications:

- ISO 21001:2018 (education), ISO 14001:2015 (environment), ISO 50001:2018 (energy), and ISO 22000:2018 (food safety).

28. Axis Bank contributed ₹100 crore from its CSR fund to set up a technology and innovation research park at the BITS Pilani Hyderabad campus.

29. Book Launch & Notable Record

- Book Launch: Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla released a book titled "IIT: The Story of India's Most Prestigious Educational Ecosystem".
- Oldest Living Land Animal: Jonathan the tortoise, residing in Seychelles, turned 194 years old (born in 1832).

30. Important Days

- International Yoga Day, Summer Solstice & World Music Day (June 21): The 12th edition of Yoga Day (started in 2015) was observed globally with the theme "Yoga for Healthy Aging". PM Modi hosted the main event at Red Road, Kolkata, while Vice President Radhakrishnan participated in Leh, Ladakh.
- June 21 also marked the Summer Solstice (longest day in the Northern Hemisphere) and World Music Day (started in France in 1982).
- World Hydrography Day (June 21): Established by the International Hydrographic Organization for water resource mapping awareness.
- World Rainforest Day (June 22): Theme "The Forest Within You". Highlights the critical role of standing forests in climate and biodiversity.
