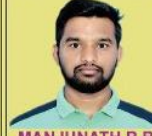

- 2) కొన్ని ఇతర కోచింగ్ సెంటర్లు ఆటో డ్రైవర్లతో కుమ్మక్కై ఒక విద్యార్థిని చేర్చిస్తే ఆ ఆటో డ్రైవర్ కి కొంత మూల్యాన్ని, బిరియాని, మొదలగునవి సమర్పిస్తున్నారు. (దయచేసి పైన పేర్కొన్న భాగిని మీరే పూరించగలరు)

5. ಅಭಿನಂದನಾ ಸಭೆ ಅಥವಾ ವಿಜಯಯಾತ್ರೆ ಎಂಬ ಹೆಸರಿನಲ್ಲಿ ಸುಮಾರು 5000 ವಿದ್ಯಾರ್ಥಿಗಳನ್ನು ಸೇರಿಸಿ, NBCC ಕೋಚಿಂಗ್ ಸೆಂಟರ್ ಮೇಲೆ ಕಬ್ಬಿಣದ ರಾಡ್, ಕಲ್ಲುಗಳಿಂದ ಹಲ್ಲೆ ನಡೆಸುವ ಯತ್ನ ನಡೆದಿದೆ.

1. Ranks, Reports & Surveys

- **UP topped revenue-surplus states** with ₹37,000 crore in FY23, according to the **CAG report**.
- **Global Innovation Index (GII) 2025** – India ranked **38th** out of 139 countries (**up from 39th in 2024**); Switzerland topped for the 15th consecutive year. India ranked **1st among Lower-Middle-Income (LMI) economies**.
- **Maharashtra** ranked **India's richest state** with **1.78 lakh millionaire households**, as per the **Hurun Wealth Report 2025**.

2. Appointments & Resignations

- **Mithun Manhas** elected as **37th BCCI President**, succeeding **Roger Binny**.
- **Shirish Chandra Murmu** appointed **Deputy Governor of RBI** for 3 years (from **October 9, 2025**).
- **Praveen Kumar** appointed **DG of ITBP till 2030**; **Praveer Ranjan** appointed **DG of CISF till 2029**.
- **Amita Chaudhury** appointed **Chairperson of UNEP FI PSI Board**, becoming the **first Indian-origin woman** to hold the post.
- **Sushila Karki** appointed as **Nepal's first woman Prime Minister**.
- **Asia's first woman loco pilot, Surekha Yadav**, to **retire on 30 September 2025** after 36 years of service.

3. Arts & Cultural Affairs

- **Hindi film "Homebound"**, directed by **Neeraj Ghaywan** and produced by **Karan Johar & Adar Poonawalla**, was selected as **India's official entry for the 2026 Oscars** (Best International Feature Film category).
- **Malayalam actor Mohanlal** received the **Dadasaheb Phalke Award 2023**.
- **Doordarshan** celebrated its **66th Foundation Day** with the theme **"Shabdanjali: DD@66"**.

4. Awards, Rewards, Recognition & Prizes

- **Ousmane Dembélé** and **Aitana Bonmatí** won the **Ballon d'Or 2025**.
- **Sheetal Devi** became the **first woman armless archer** to win a **World Championship gold** (Para World Archery 2025, South Korea).
- **Minakshi Hooda** and **Jaismine Lamboria** won **gold medals at World Boxing Championships 2025** (Liverpool, UK).

- **Jaismine Lamboria** won **gold** in the **57kg featherweight category**, defeating an Olympic silver medallist.
- **Vaishali Rameshbabu** won the **Women's FIDE Grand Swiss 2025**, qualifying for the **2026 Candidates Tournament**.
- **Vaishali Rameshbabu** later won the **2026 FIDE Women's Candidates Tournament** in **Samarkand, Uzbekistan**.
- **Anandkumar Velkumar** won **India's first-ever gold medal** in the **Speed Skating World Championships** (China).
- **Central Zone** won the **62nd Duleep Trophy (2025–26)** under **Rajat Patidar's** captaincy.
- **Smriti Mandhana** broke **Virat Kohli's** record, scoring the **fastest ODI century** by an Indian (50 balls).
- **Andhra Pradesh** won '**Best State Award**' under the "**Mera Resham-Mera Abhiman**" programme (Central Silk Board).

5. Banking, Finance, Insurance & Economic Affairs

- **US** became the **largest FDI source** for **India** in **Q1 FY26**, contributing **₹48,104 crore** inflows — a **282% year-on-year rise**.
- **RBI** set up a "**Regulatory Review Cell (RRC)**" with an **Advisory Group on Regulation (AGR)** chaired by **Rana Ashutosh Kumar Singh (MD, SBI)**.
- **NSE** launched "**Ideabaaz**", **India's first integrated startup–investor marketplace**.
- **OECD** raised **India's FY26 growth forecast** to **6.7%** (ADB – 6.5%, IMF – 6.2%, World Bank – 6.3%).
- **R&I (Japan)** upgraded **India's sovereign rating** to **BBB+ (stable outlook)** in **2025**.
- **India's economy** grew **7.8%** in **Q1 FY26**, the **highest in the last 5 quarters**.
- **SBI Foundation** launched the '**SBI Platinum Jubilee Asha Scholarship 2025**' with a **₹90 crore commitment for FY26**, supporting **23,230 students**.
- **Apollo Tyres** bagged a **₹579 crore BCCI sponsorship deal** till **March 2028**.
- **NPCI** raised the **UPI Person-to-Merchant (P2M)** daily transaction limit to **₹10 lakh**, benefiting capital markets, insurance, travel, EMI, and credit card payments.

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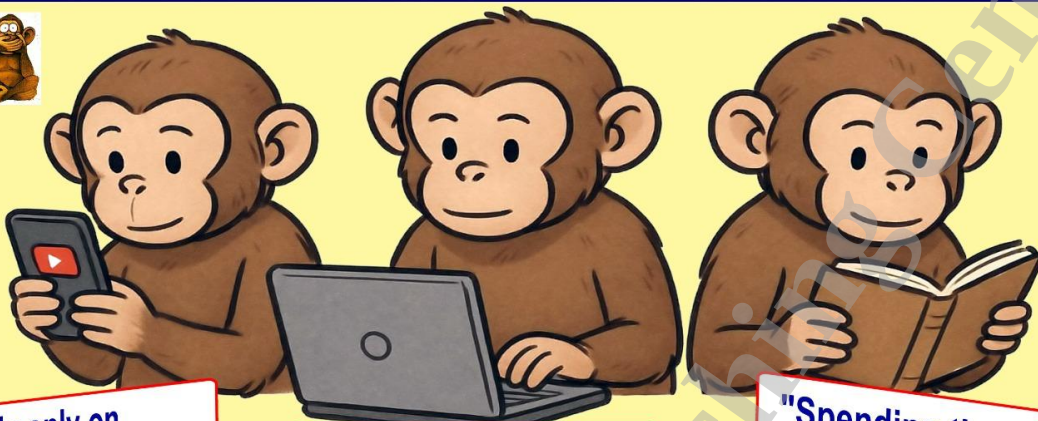
